To be eligible you must:			
Be a graduating student pursuing post-secondary education in the area of Social Sciences (e.g. History, Geography, Canadian Law, Sociology or Economics). Student already has, or will have, completed two (2) senior social science credits by graduation. Open to all students, and not necessarily for the 'academic elite'. This scholarship supports students who are strong, honest, hardworking, reliable, with a history of community service or other volunteering activities, as well as possessing strong leadership skills. Financial means will also be taken into consideration.			
To renew the scholarship, you must			
Achieve an 80% average in each subsequent year of post-secondary study, as well as maintain full-time registration in the Faculty to which you were admitted.
