To be eligible you must:

Be a graduating student **pursuing post-secondary education - in the area of social sciences** (History, Geography, Canadian Law, Sociology or Economics). The student must demonstrate a reasonable level of academic achievement but not considered to be the 'academic elite'. This scholarship supports students who have previously demonstrated a concern for the general welfare of their community, as well as possessing strong leadership skills. Financial means will also be taken into consideration.

Additional documents to include with your application (in pdf format):

1. A letter outlining:
 - Your academic and career goals
 - The nature of your community service; which experience was the most satisfying and why
 - Your leadership accomplishments and contribution to extracurricular activities in school
2. Your most recent transcript.
3. Two letters of recommendation. One current teacher and one other may be a member from the community.
